

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 (1)

Temporary Road Closure Heath Road, Twickenham

(Ref: 19/005)

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate railway bridge assessment works, they intend to make a temporary Traffic Order to restrict traffic in Heath Road, Twickenham.
- Whilst the works take place, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed, wait or stand in Heath Road from a point 10 metres north-east of the railway bridge, south-westwards to a point 10 metres south-west of the railway bridge – outside 176 Heath Road
- 3. The order will come into effect on 23 January 2019. The restrictions will be in force between 9pm on 23 January 2019 and 5am on 24 January 2019. The order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicles affected by the closure will be available via Heath Road, A310, Waldegrave Road, A313, Stanley Road, Sixth Cross Road and Heath Road and vice versa.
- 5. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
- 6. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Notice may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
