

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 (1)

Temporary Road Closure Cedar Terrace, Richmond

(Ref: 19/028)

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate vehicular access to be maintained to facilitate a large delivery, they intend to make a temporary Traffic Order to restrict traffic in Cedar Terrace, Richmond.
- 2. Whilst the works take place, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in Cedar Terrace, Richmond between a point outside No,. 97 Cedar Terrace and a point outside No. 102 Cedar Terrace.
- 3. The order will come into effect on 8 March 2019. The restrictions will be in force between 8 March 2019 and 10 March 2019. The order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
- 4. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
- 5. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 6. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Notice may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
