

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 16A

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (SPECIAL EVENTS) (VARIOUS SCHOOL STREETS) ORDER 2019**VARIOUS ROADS IN THE BOROUGH**

(Reference 19/043)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames on the 21 March 2019 made the above Order under section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The general effect of this Order is to facilitate the introduction of School Streets in various streets in the Borough on Monday 25 March 2019.
3. The streets which will be closed are listed in the Schedule to this notice. Full details of the lengths of street which will be closed and times when the closure will be in force will be contained in the order referred to in the next paragraph

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (SPECIAL EVENTS) (VARIOUS SCHOOL STREETS) ORDER 2019

Made: 21 March 2019

Comes into operation: 25 March 2019

WHEREAS the Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (hereinafter referred to as "The Council") being the Highway Authority for all streets within the said London borough, with the exception of those streets which are part of the Transport for London Road Network and those which are Crown roads in the Royal Parks of Richmond Park and Bushy Park, (hereinafter referred to as "the borough roads") are satisfied that vehicular traffic should be restricted in order that School Streets may be introduced in various borough roads as promoted by local community groups:

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended, and of all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order: -

Commencement and citation

1. This Order shall come into operation on 25 March 2019 and may be cited as The London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Special Events) (Various School Streets) Order 2019 and shall remain in force for one day only.

Interpretation

- 2 (1) In this order, the following expressions shall have the meanings hereinafter assigned: -

"police community support officer" shall mean a person who has been so designated as such by the Metropolitan Police Service as provided for by section 38 of the Police Reform Act 2002(b) and is wearing an approved uniform as provided for by section 41 of that Act;

"specified day" shall mean the day specified in column 2 of any item of the Schedule;

"restricted street" means the street named in column 3 of any item of the Schedule, subject to such limitation as may be specified;

"restricted hours", in relation to any restricted street, means the hours specified in column 5 of any item in the Schedule;

"Schedule" means the schedule to this order.

- (2) The Interpretation Act 1978**(c)** shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Prohibition of Traffic

3. No person may cause any vehicle to proceed in any restricted street on any specified day during the restricted hours. Access will be maintained where possible.

Exemptions

- 4 Nothing in this Order shall apply: -
- (a) to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a police community support officer; or
 - (b) to any vehicle on an occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes, if the observance of that provision would be likely to hinder the use of the vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used on that occasion.

Traffic Signs

5. The provisions of this Order will only apply during such times and to such extent as is at the time indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016**(d)**, as amended.
