

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 23
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 – SECTION 90C**

SIGNALISED RAISED CROSSING

LONDON ROAD, TWICKENHAM

(Reference 19/046)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames proposes to install a signalised raised crossing outside the railway station on London Road.

The controlled area of the crossing will be sited from a point 73.6 metres north-west of the north-western kerb-line of Railway Approach extending north-westwards some 63 metres in the south-eastern bound lane and extending some 50 metres in the north-western-bound lane. The table will be sited some 90 metres north-west of the north-western kerb-line of Railway Approach, with a length, including ramps of 12.6 metres. The ramps will have a 1:20 gradient.

A drawing showing the proposed design will be available for public inspection for a period of 21 days from the date of this notice, quoting reference 19/046 at: -

- (a) the Civic Centre (Central Reception, ground floor), 44 York Street, Twickenham between 9.15am and 5pm on Mondays to Fridays, except for Bank and other public holidays; or
