Temporary Closure of Public Right of Way PRW 26 Thorne Passage, Barnes

(Reference 19/046)

- The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate the installation of a dry riser, they intend to make a temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a temporary closure of a section of PRW 26, - Thorne Passage, Barnes.
- Whilst the works take place, no person shall enter PRW 26, Thorne Passage from a point outside the rear of No 17 Charles Street to a point outside the rear of No 27F Charles Street.
- 3. The order will come into effect on 8 April 2019. The restrictions will be in force at all times from 8 April 2019 until 19 April 2019 and whilst signs/cones are in place. The order will remain in force for a period of 6 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
- 4. An alternative route for anyone affected by the closure will be available via White Hart Labe and Charles Street.
- 5. The prohibitions apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
