

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

**Temporary Waiting Restriction
Ham Common and Upper Ham Road, Ham**

(Ref: 19/048)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate utility works works, they intend to make a temporary Traffic Order to restrict traffic in Ham Common and Upper Ham Road.
2. Whilst the works take place, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or stand in the following lengths of street: -
 - (a) Upper Ham Road, on its eastern side, from a point outside the south-western boundary of Ivy Cottage, north-eastwards for a distance of 35 metres;
 - (b) Ham Common on its north-eastern side, from a point 30 metres north-west of its junction with Upper Ham Road, north-westwards for a distance of 50 metres.
3. The order will come into effect on 8 April 2019. The restrictions will be in force at all times from 8 April 2019 until 12 April 2019. The order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
4. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
5. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
6. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Notice may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
