

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

**Temporary Footpath Closure
Step Access Between Ranelagh Drive and Kew Riverside
Walk, Twickenham**

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate painting works to Richmond Lock and Weir footbridge, they have made a temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a closure to the access to the step access between Ranelagh Drive and Kew Riverside Walk.
2. Whilst the works take place, no person may proceed in the step access between Ranelagh Drive and Kew Riverside Walk.
3. The order will come into effect on 24 June 2019. The works are anticipated to be in progress from 24 June 2019 until 29 November 2019, or until the works are completed, whichever is the sooner. The provisions of the order will be in force at all times where relevant signs are placed. The order will remain in force for a period of 6 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
4. The prohibitions apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.

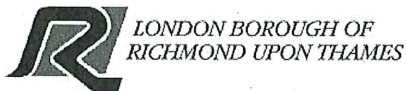

1. TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH) (STEP ACCESS BETWEEN RANELAGH DRIVE AND KEW RIVERSIDE WALK, TWICKENHAM) ORDER 2019

Made: 13 June 2019

Comes into operation: 24 June 2019

WHEREAS the Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (hereinafter referred to as "The Council") being the Highway Authority for all streets within the said London borough, with the exception of those streets which are part of the Transport for London Road Network and those which are Crown roads in the Royal Parks of Richmond Park and Bushy Park, are satisfied that vehicular traffic should be prohibited and car parking restricted in order to facilitate painting works. (hereinafter referred to as "the works"):

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended, and of all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order: -

Commencement and citation

1. This Order shall come into operation on 24 June 2019 and may be cited as the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Temporary Closure of Footpath) (Step Access Between Ranelagh Drive and Kew Riverside Walk, Twickenham) Order 2019 and shall remain in force for a period of six months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the sooner.

Interpretation

- 2, (1) In this order, the following expressions shall have the meanings hereby assigned to each respectively: -

"The Council" means Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames;

"enactment" means any enactment whether public, general or local and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by an enactment;

- (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
- (3) The Interpretation Act 1978(c) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Prohibition or restriction of pedestrian traffic

- 3. (1) Between 24 June 2019 and 29 November 2019 inclusive, no person may proceed in the step access between Ranelagh Drive and Kew Riverside Walk.
- (2) Nothing in paragraph (1) of this Article shall apply to
 - (a) any person engaged in the execution of the said works
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform.
