- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames propose to make the above Order under section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The general effect of the **20 MPH SPEED LIMIT AMENDMENT ORDER** will be to introduce a 20 mile per hour speed limit in the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames in lengths of the roads and streets identified in the Schedule to this Notice.

THE COUNCIL OF THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), after giving public notice and consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 84 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984"), as amended, and all other powers so enabling hereby make the following Order—

- This Order may be cited as the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Borough-wide) (20 mph Speed Limit) (Amendment No. *) Order 202* and shall come into operation on **** 202*.
- 2. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Borough-wide) (20mph Speed Limit) Order 2019(c), , shall have effect as though there was added to that Order the roads, streets and parts of streets detailed in the Schedule to this Order.
- 3. Nothing in Article 2 of this order shall apply to any vehicle falling within the scope of paragraph (4) of Regulation 3 of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(b) when that vehicle is being used in accordance with paragraph (5) of that regulation.

SCHEDULE

(See Article 2)

Roads, streets and parts thereof, to be added to the Schedule to the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Borough-wide) (20 mph Speed Limit) Order 2019 where any such length of road or street is identified as public highway where the maximum speed limit shall be 20 miles per hour.

Hampton Court Road, Hampton, from its junction with Thames Street eastwards to a point 150 metres east of the western kerb-line of Hogarth Way;

Thames Street, Hampton;

Upper Sunbury Road, Hampton, from a point 30 metres east of the western kerb-line of Lower Sunbury Road, to its junction with Thames Street.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order introduces a speed limit of 20 miles per hour in all roads, streets and parts thereof, where any such length of road or street is identified as public highway.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The Council plans to reduce the speed limit on most roads in the boroughs to 20mph, with the exception of the TLRN, This Order amends the exiting Order to introduce a 20 mph speed limit in

Hampton Court Road, Hampton, from its junction with Thames Street eastwards to a point 150 metres east of the western kerb-line of Hogarth Way;

Thames Street, Hampton:

Upper Sunbury Road, Hampton, from a point 30 metres east of the western kerb-line of Lower Sunbury Road, to its junction with Thames Street.

The aims of the project ise to:

- Reduce vehicle speeds on our roads, particularly on those roads which have the highest speed
- Reduce the number and severity of accidents
- Create environments which are more conducive to walking and cycling
- Lead to an overall improvement in the liveability of neighborhoods
- Create a more consistent landscape of 20mph across London in line with neighbouring boroughs
- Reduce the need for physical traffic calming measures
