

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

**Temporary road closures
Manor Road, Richmond
18-26 November 2012**

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate essential maintenance works at the level crossing in Manor Road, Richmond they have made a temporary Order, the effect of which is to introduce a series of four separate road closures in Manor Road.
2. Whilst the works take place no person may permit a vehicle to proceed in Manor Road between its junction with Manor Grove and its junction with Manor Park.
3. Whilst Manor Road, Richmond is closed, an alternative route for northbound traffic will be Upper Richmond Road West, Clifford Avenue, Lower Richmond Road and . An alternative route for southbound traffic will be as above but in the reverse direction.
4. The order will come into effect on 18 November 2012. The works are anticipated to be in progress as set out in the following table. The order will remain in force for a period of 3 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.

Date	Times of closure
Sunday 18 November 2012	1am to 4am
Monday 19 November 2012	1am to 4am
Sunday 25 November 2012	1am to 4am
Monday 26 November 2012	1am to 4am

5. The prohibitions apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
6. Nothing in the Order applies to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden; or
 - (c) emergency service vehicles, subject to site conditions at the time of any emergency.
7. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
