## Temporary road closure at level crossing in Percy Road, Hampton

## Temporary waiting restrictions in Ashley Road, Hampton 12-13 January 2013

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate works at the Hampton level crossing in Percy Road they intend to make a temporary Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a road closure in Percy Road, Hampton and waiting restrictions in Ashley Road.
- 2. Percy Road will be closed from its junction with Station Road to its junction with Ashley Road from 11pm on Saturday 12 January 2013.
- 3. Waiting restrictions will be in force in Ashley Road from its junction with Mary Rose Close to a point near No 6 Station Approach, Hampton. These will apply to the whole of this length on both sides of the road, including all limited time parking bays, and will come into force at 8pm on Saturday 12 January.
- 4. The works are anticipated to be in progress until 7.00am on Sunday 13 January. The order will remain in force for a period of 3 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
- 5. Whilst Percy Road, Hampton is closed, an alternative route for northbound traffic will be Station Road, Station Approach and Ashley Road. An alternative route for southbound traffic will be as above but in the reverse direction.
- 6. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 7. Nothing in the Order will apply to:
  - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works; or
  - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden.
- 8. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed.
