NOTICE OF INTENT 2013 NO. 1285

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 (1)

Temporary road closure, waiting restrictions and suspension of one-way working Cumberland Road, Kew 13 January 2013

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate the deployment of a mobile crane and associated delivery vehicles outside No 17 Cumberland Road they intend to make a temporary Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a temporary road closure, waiting restrictions and the suspension of one-way working in Cumberland Road, Kew.
- 2. Cumberland Road will be closed to all traffic for an overall distance of approximately 100 metres near No 17 Cumberland Road to allow the works to take place and ensure the safety of residents and members of the general public. Within this section, waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" will be in force and will apply to resident permit parking bays and any lengths of single yellow lines. The normal one-way working at the northern end and at the southern end of Cumberland Road (the parts which are not closed) will be suspended.
- 3. The waiting restrictions will come into force at midnight on Sunday 13 January. The road closure and two-way working is anticipated to be introduced at 8am. The restrictions will be lifted as soon as the works are complete and it is safe to do so, but in any case no later than 6pm on 13 January.
- 4. The order will remain in force on every Sunday for a period of 3 months, to allow the works to be rescheduled of on account of high winds or other unexpected events.
- 5. Whilst Cumberland Road is closed, an alternative route for southbound traffic will be via A205 Mortlake Road, High Park Road and Kew Gardens Road.
- 6. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 7. Nothing in the Order will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works; or
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform, a police community support officer or a traffic warden.
- 8. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed.
