## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 (1)

## Temporary Waiting Restrictions Argyle Avenue and Whitton Waye, Whitton

(Ref: 20/036)

- The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate gas main replacement works they intend to make a Temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which is to introduce a temporary waiting restriction in Argyle Avenue and Whitton Waye, Whitton.
- 2. Whilst the works take place, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or stand in Argyle Avenue and Whitton Waye. The works will be carried on a rolling basis.
- The Order will come into effect on 16 March 2020. The restrictions will be in force at all times from 16 March 2020 until 27 March 2020. The order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
- Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
  - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works;
  - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
  - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
- 5. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Notice may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
