

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

**Temporary Waiting Restrictions and Road Closure  
Kew Green and Gloucester Road, Kew**

(Ref: 20/054)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate a power connection they intend to make a Temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which is to introduce a temporary prohibition of traffic in Kew Green and Gloucester Road, Kew.
2. Whilst the works take place,
  - (a) no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed, wait or stand in the Kew Green Service Road between its junction with Kew Road and Gloucester Road;
  - (b) no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or stand in Kew Green and Gloucester Road between No 1 Gloucester Road and a point outside No. 10 Kew Green.
3. The Order will come into effect on 14 April 2020. The restrictions will be in force at all times from 14 April 2020 until 29 April 2020. The order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
4. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
  - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works;
  - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
  - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
5. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Notice may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
