## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 (2)

## Temporary Waiting Restrictions and Disabled Person's Parking Bay Bushy Park Road, Teddington

(Ref: 20/071)

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate a parking place for a disabled person's vehicle owing to displaced parking to allow deliveries to take place, they will introduce a temporary restriction in Bushy Park Road, Teddington.
- 2. Whilst the works take place, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or stand in Bushy Park Road, on its eastern side, from a point 5 metres south of the southern kerb-line of Fairfax Road, southwards for a distance of 6.6 metres.
- 3. The restrictions will come into force on 18 May 2020. Further details regarding the dates and times of the restrictions are explained in paragraph 5 of this notice.
- 4. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
  - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works;
  - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer;
  - (c) the disabled person's vehicle with the registration number detailed on the sign adjacent to the parking area;
  - (d) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
- 5. The temporary restrictions will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect on 18 May 2020 and remain in force for a maximum period of 5 days. If the works continue beyond this date, the Council will introduce an Order under S14(1) of the said Act of 1984 to continue in force the provisions of this Notice for up to 18 months. The works are expected to be completed by 6 June 2020.
- 6. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 7. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
