ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2) (b)

Temporary Waiting Restrictions Kew Road, Kew

(Ref: 20/074)

- The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate social distancing as a result of the SARS-CoV-2 (coronavirus) pandemic and due to the likelihood of danger to the public, they will introduce a waiting restriction in Kew Road, Kew
- 2. Whilst the Notice remains in force, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or stand at any time in Kew Road on its north-western side, from a point outside Kew Gardens Lion Gate north-eastwards to a point opposite the junction of Kew Gardens Road.
- 3. The restrictions will come into force on 30 May 2020. Further details regarding the dates and times of the restrictions are explained in paragraph 5 of this notice.
- 4. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution highway works;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer;
 - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
- 5. The temporary restrictions will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) (b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect on 30 May 2020 and remain in force for a maximum period of 21 days. If the restrictions continue beyond this date, the Council will introduce an Order under S14(1) of the said Act of 1984 to continue in force the provisions of this Notice for up to 18 months. The Council is proposing in due course to introduce an Order under Section 9 of the said Act to give a long-term effect to these restrictions.
 - 6. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
 - 7. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
