Temporary Footbridge Closure Amyand Park Road Railway Footbridge

(Reference 20/156)

- The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate footbridge repairs, they intend to make a temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a temporary closure of Amyand Park Road Railway footbridge.
- 2. Whilst the works take place, no person shall proceed over the railway footbridge in Amyand Park Road which links Amyand Park Road and Drummond Place.
- 3. The order will come into effect on 1 December 2020. The restrictions will be in force at all times from 1 December 2020 until 31 December 2020 and whilst signs/cones are in place. The order will remain in force for a period of 6 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
- 4. An alternative route for anyone affected by the closure will be available via St Margarets Road.
- 5. The prohibitions apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 6. Nothing in the Order applies to:
 - (a) any person requiring access in connection with the execution of the said works;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (c) any person requiring access for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
