

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2)

**Temporary Road Closure
Queens Road, Teddington**

(Ref: 21/022)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate a water connection they have introduced a road closure in Queens Road, Teddington.
2. Whilst this Notice remains in force, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed, wait or stand in Queens Road, Teddington between its junction with Brad Street and a point outside No, 5 Queens Road.
3. The restrictions will come into force on 1 February 2021 and remain in force for a maximum period of 5 days. Should the works continue beyond this time, the Council will make an Order under S14(1) of the said Act, to continue in force the provisions this Notice for up to 18 months. The works are expected to be completed by 24 February 2021.
4. An alternative route for vehicles affected by the closure will be available via Hampton Road, Gloucester Road, Stanley Road and Broad Street.
5. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
 - (a) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer;
 - (b) any vehicle engaged in the said works;
 - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
6. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
7. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
