

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2) (b)

**Temporary Restrictions
Clarence Street, Richmond**

(Ref: 21/102)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to road subsidence they have introduced a road closure in Clarence Street, Richmond.
2. Whilst this Notice remains in force, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in Clarence Street between its junction with Parkshot and the south-eastern boundary of the Orange Tree Public House.
3. The one-way working in Clarence Street shall be suspended.
4. The restrictions will come into 25 June 2021 and remain in force for a maximum period of 21 days. Should the works continue beyond this time, the Council will make an Order under S14(1) of the said Act, to continue in force the provisions this Notice for up to 18 months.
5. A signed alternative route for vehicles affected by the closure will be available via adjacent streets.
6. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
 - (a) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer;
 - (b) any vehicle engaged in the said works;
 - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
7. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
8. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
