

LONDON LOCAL AUTHORITIES ACT 1995 – SECTION 9

**Temporary Waiting Restrictions
Ham Common, Ham Gate Avenue and Upper Ham Road, Ham**

(Reference 21/141)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate the holding of Ham Fair they will prohibit parking in lengths of Ham Common, Ham Gate Avenue and Upper Ham Road, Ham under powers conferred by Section 9 of the London local Authorities Act 1995
2. Whilst the event take place, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or stand in the following lengths of street:-
 - Ham Common, the north-east side, from the north-western kerb-line of Upper Ham Road, north-westwards for a distance of 20 metres;
 - Ham Common the south-east and north-east sides, from a point opposite the south-eastern boundary of No 25 Ham Common, north-westwards and north-eastwards for a distance of 40 metres;
 - Ham Common, the south side, from its junction with Upper Ham Road, westwards to a point 20 metres west of the western boundary of “Avenue Lodge”
 - Upper Ham Road, the north-west side, from the north-eastern kerb-line of Ham Common, north-eastwards for a distance of 20 metres and from the south-western kerb-line of Ham Common, south-westwards for a distance of 20 metres;
 - Ham Gate Avenue, both sides, from its junction with Upper Ham Road, eastwards for a distance of 120 metres.
3. The restrictions shall be in effect on Saturday 11 September 2021 between 7am and 8pm.
4. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
5. Nothing in the Notice applies to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (c) emergency service vehicles, subject to site conditions at the time of any emergency.

Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
