

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

**Temporary Waiting Restrictitons
Priory Road and Tudor Road, Hampton**

(Ref: 21/180)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate a water main repair they intend to make a Temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to introduce waiting restrictions in Priory Road and Tudor Road, Hampton.
2. Whilst the works take place no person may permit a vehicle to wait or stand in the following lengths of road: -
 - (a) Priory Road, from a point 30 metres west of the western kerb-line of Tudor Road to a point 30 metres east of the eastern kerb-line of Tudor Road;
 - (b) Tudor Road, from a point 30 metres south of the southern kerb-line of Priory Road to a point 30 metres north of the northern kerb-line of Priory Road.
3. The order will come into effect on 26 October 2021. The restrictions will operate on 26 and 27 October 2021. The order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
4. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
5. Nothing in the Order will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (c) emergency service vehicles.
6. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
