

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2) (b)

**Temporary Restrictions
Queens Road, Twickenham**

(Ref: 21/187)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate urgent water main repairs and due to the likelihood of danger to the public they have introduced a road closure in Queens Road, Twickenham.
2. Whilst this Notice remains in force, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in Queens Road between its junctions with Holly Road and Sherland Road.
3. The restrictions will come into force on 18 October 2021 and remain in force for a maximum period of 21 days. Should the works continue beyond this time, the Council will make an Order under S14(1) of the said Act, to continue in force the provisions this Notice for up to 18 months. It is expected that the works will be completed by 23 October 2021.
4. A signed diversion for vehicles affected by the closure will be available via adjacent streets.
5. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
 - (a) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer.
 - (b) any vehicle engaged in the said works.
 - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
6. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
7. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
