

LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES  
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14

**Temporary road closure  
Eton Street, Richmond**

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to works a section of Eton Street, Richmond is required to be CLOSED to all vehicular traffic. The works will involve the following:
  - Thames Water basement flooding investigative & repair work
  - Essential utility connections to the site under construction at Nos. 1-5 Lower George Street; and
  - Removal of large tower crane/hoist from that site.
2. Whilst the works take place no person may permit a vehicle to proceed in Eton Street from its junction with The Quadrant to the mid point of Eton Street. Access to Eton House and Towers Place will be maintained by allowing two-way traffic to use that part of Eton Street which is not subject to the road closure. These restrictions will apply at any time and when prescribed traffic signs are displayed.
3. The times it is anticipated that Eton Street will be closed are between 3 October and 16 October 2012.
4. Traffic will be diverted via Sheen Road and Paradise Road.
5. These temporary restrictions are being introduced by this notice given under section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and will be continued in force by an order made under section 14(1) of that Act. It is anticipated that the works will be completed on 16 October 2012. However, the order will remain in force for a period of up to 28 days, to allow for unexpected delays to the works.
6. Nothing in this Notice or the Order will apply to:
  - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works; or
  - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden.
7. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
8. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
