- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames on 11 April 2013 made the above Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. These orders are made following the consideration by the Council of a number of objections received in respect of the proposals published on 7 December 2012.
- 2. The general effect of the **Free Parking, Ambulance Vehicles Amendment Order** will be to introduce a new parking bay for use by ambulances on the west side of Dean Road, Hampton near its junction with Rectory Grove. The bay will be 12 metres long and will be in operation at all times.
- 3. The general effect of the **Kew Parking Places Amendment Order** will be to shorten two parking bays in Defoe Avenue, Kew by 1.5 metres each. The bays are permit holder bays (resident permits and business permits) within the Kew CPZ and are being shortened to allow double yellow lines to be introduced. Please see Article 5 below for particulars of the waiting restrictions. This is a modification to the proposed scheme in the light of representations received.
- 4. The general effect of the **South Kew Parking Places Amendment Order** affects two parking bays in Gainsborough Road, Kew, in the vicinity of the bend near Nos 37-47

Gainsborough Road. The bays are permit holder bays (resident permits and business permits) within the South Kew CPZ. The bay on the outside of the bend is to be adjusted so that vehicles are required to park with two wheels on the footway. The bay on the inside of the bend (outside No 30 Gainsborough Road) is being shortened by 5 metres.

- 5. The general effect of the **Waiting and Loading Restriction Amendment Order** will be to introduce waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" and loading restrictions "no loading at any time" at the places specified in Schedules 1 and 2 respectively to this notice, and to remove short length of restrictions as set out in Schedule 3. The proposals in respect of Gomer Place, Teddington and Kneller Road, Whitton have been withdrawn.
- 6. Copies of the Orders, which will come into effect on Monday 15 April 2013, plans showing the location and effect of the orders and the Council's Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Orders:-
 - (a) can be inspected, quoting Reference 57/12, at the Civic Centre (Central Reception, ground floor), 44 York Street, Twickenham between 9.15am and 5pm on Mondays to Fridays, except for Bank and other public holidays; and

Restriction applies on the north-west side outside Nos 4-8 Ashfield Close. See note to Schedule 1.

Restriction applies on both sides from its junction with the vehicular entrance to the NPL to a point 5 metres east of its junction with Oakhurst Close.

High Street, Teddington:

Restriction applies on the south side outside Nos 100 and 102 High Street.

Market Road, Richmond:

Restriction applies on the west side for 6 metres on either side of its junction with Garden Road.

Nelson Road, Whitton:

Extends by 2 metres an existing restriction on the north side outside No 154 Nelson Road.

Oldfield Road, Hampton:

- (a) extends by 2 metres an existing restriction on the north side outside Field House, No 72 Oldfield Road;
- (b) extends by 12 metres an existing restriction on the north side outside Nos 80-82 Oldfield Road;
- (c) extends by 15 metres an existing restriction on the south side outside the flank wall of No 34 Percy Road.

Orchard Road, Richmond:

Restriction applies on the east side for 6 metres on either side of its junction with Garden Road.

Percy Road, Hampton:

Restriction applies for 16 metres on the west side outside Nos 73-75 Percy Road.

Rocks Lane, Barnes:

Restriction applies for on both sides of the unnamed access road leading to the Rocks Lane sports centre, between its junction with Rocks Lane and the entrance to the drop-off area for the tennis club.

School Road, Hampton Hill:

Restriction applies:

- (a) on the north-west side for 39 metres outside the new housing development at Nos 19-28 School Road;
- (b) on the south-east side from a point outside the party wall of Nos 2 and 3 School Road to its junction with School Road Avenue. See note to Schedule 1.

Victor Road, Teddington:

Restriction applies for 6.5 metres on the south-east side outside No 102 Victor Road. See note to Schedule 1.

Note to Schedule 1

The restrictions to which this note applies are, in each case, a modification to the proposed scheme where the restrictions have been reduced in the light of representations received.





Notes to Schedule 3

Note 1 This note refers to item 3/24, column 5, special manner of standing. For a part of this parking place vehicles are required to stand with two wheels resting on the footway. The part affected is from a point 20 metres northwest of the western kerb-line of Sandycombe Road north-westwards then northwards to a point opposite the common boundary of Nos 47 and 49 Gainsborough Road.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order amends the existing parking places in Gainsborough Avenue.

When the CPZ was originally introduced in 2004, the parking bays outside Nos 1-35 Gainsborough Avenue (the south-west side) had been introduced as being partly on the footway, although the order which was made at that time did not reflect that special manner of standing. This order now does include that provision, and, in addition, extends the footway parking to a point outside No 47 Gainsborough Avenue.

This order also increases by 5 metres the minimum total length not to be occupied by parking places in respect of item 3/28 to reflect the fact that the parking bay outside No 30 Gainsborough Avenue has been shortened by 5 metres.

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THESE ORDERS

The Council receives reports from time to time on matters of road safety caused by parked vehicles and may come from residents, Councillors or bus and emergency services. These matters include poor sight lines at junctions, obstruction of footway crossing points, lack of suitable passing areas and reduced carriageway width restricting or preventing access for vehicles especially emergency service vehicles.

This Order is intended to improve road safety for all users by introducing waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" at the locations listed in the Explanatory Notes to each of the orders. Similar restrictions have proved effective in locations elsewhere in the borough that previously suffered similar problems.

An ambulance parking bay in Dean Road, Hampton is being introduced at the request of the London Ambulance Service to provide a safe and convenient pick-up and drop-off point for elderly residents of the Dean Road Extra Care Scheme.

The shortening of the parking bays in Defoe Avenue, Kew, together with the waiting restrictions to be introduced in their place will provide space for vehicles to be turned round at the end of this cul-de-sac road.

The adjustment of on-street parking bays in Gainsborough Road, Kew will provide additional space to allow an easier passage of vehicles at the bend in this road.
