LONSDALE ROAD, BARNES THE BROADWAY, MORTLAKE

- The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames on 25 February 2013 made the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The principal objective of these Orders is to allow two experimental traffic management schemes (introduced in August and September 2011) to be continued on a permanent basis.
- 3. The general effect of the Free Parking Order is to make permanent the limited time parking places in Lonsdale Road, Barnes (by the Small Profits Dock) and in The Broadway, Mortlake (the junction of Mortlake High Street, White Hart Lane and The Terrace). The sole effect of this Order is to replicate and continue in force indefinitely the provisions of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Free Parking Places) (No. 2) Experimental Order 2011 and The London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Free Parking Places) (Limited Time) (No. 3) Experimental Order 2011.
- 4. The general effect of the loading places revocation Order is to revoke a loading bay in the Broadway which, during the experimental scheme, had been suspended to allow the limited time parking bays to be positioned at the loading bay.
- 5. Copies of the Orders, which will come into operation on 5 March 2013, plans showing the location and effect of the schemes and the Council's Statement of Reasons for making the Orders:-
 - (a) can be inspected for a period of 6 weeks, quoting Reference 13/022, at the Civic Centre (Central Reception, ground floor), 44 York Street, Twickenham between 9.15am and 5pm on Mondays to Fridays, except for Bank and other public holidays; and
 - (b) may be viewed on the Council's web-site at http://www.richmond.gov.uk/traffic management orders.htm
- 6. Copies of the Orders may be purchased from the Environment Directorate, Civic Centre, 44 York Street, Twickenham TW1 3BZ.
- 7. If any person wishes to question the validity of the Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of the said Act of 1984 or of any instrument made under the said Act of 1984 has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders were made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.

The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, having consulted the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended, and all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order—

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 5 March 2013 and may be cited as the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Free Parking Places) (Limited Time) (Amendment No. 12) Order 2013.
- 2. (1) In this Order the expression "enactment" means any enactment whether public, general or local and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment.
 - (a) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
 - (b) The Interpretation Act 1978(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Free Parking Places) (Limited Time) (Consolidation No. 1) Order 2008(c), as amended, shall have effect as though:
 - (a) there were added to that order the item numbered 17/5 in Schedule 17 as set out in columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of Schedule 1 to this Order;
 - (b) there were added to that order the Schedule numbered 29 and the item in that Schedule numbered 29/1 as set out in columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of Schedule 2 to this Order, and
 - (c) "Schedule 29" was included in column 2 of item 3 in the table at Article 7 of that order and in column 2 of item 2 in the table at Article 13.

(This Note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order continues in force the provisions of two experimental orders as set out below.

The London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Free Parking Places) (No. 2) Experimental Order 2011 introduced a total of three limited-time free parking places in Lonsdale Road, Barnes (fully on the footway). Parking is limited to a maximum stay of one hour and no return within one hour between 8am and 6.30pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive.

The London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Free Parking Places) (No. 3) Experimental Order 2011 introduced a total of three limited-time free parking places in The Broadway, Mortlake. Parking is limited to a maximum stay of one hour and no return within one hour between 8am and 6.30pm throughout the week.

(This Note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This order revokes a loading bay in The Broadway, Mortlake. It has been suspended since September 2011 whilst an experimental scheme has been in place by which free limited time parking bays have been provided instead of the loading facility. The Council has determined that the experimental scheme should be continued in force indefinitely and, as a consequence, the loading bay is now to be revoked.

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR MAKING THESE ORDERS

The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, in August and September 2011, introduced two sets of free, limited time parking bays in the following locations:

- in Lonsdale Road, Barnes, adjacent to the "Small Profits Dock" on the River Thames, 3 parking bays fully on the footway operating between 8am and 6.30pm throughout the week with a maximum permitted stay of 1 hour and no return within 1 hour; and
- (b) in The Broadway, Mortlake a parking bay 15 metres long (space for 3 cars) operating between 8am and 6.30pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive with a maximum permitted stay of 30 minutes and no return within 1 hour.

The short term parking in Lonsdale Road was introduced following a number of requests to provide some short term parking spaces on the land adjacent to the Small Profits Dock and to generally improve road safety conditions for all users at this location.

The free limited time parking bays in The Broadway replaced a loading bay which has been suspended for the duration of the experiment. The free parking bays were intended to increase the number and turnover of parked vehicles in the vicinity for the benefit of shoppers and traders.

Both schemes were introduced on an experimental basis to give the Council powers to make modifications or variations to them in the light of operational experience.

The Council has considered the outcome of the experiments and has decided to make the permanent Orders whose titles are given above. One of these orders reproduces and continues in force indefinitely the provisions of the experimental Orders. The other revokes the loading bay in The Broadway, Mortlake.
