- The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames on 10 September 2013 made the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The principal objective of these Orders is to allow a number of experimental traffic management schemes (introduced on 12 March 2012) to be continued on a permanent basis.
- 3. The general effect of the Free Parking Places Order is to make permanent the limited time free parking places located in the streets specified in Schedule 1 to this notice. At each location the maximum stay will be 30 minutes. Waiting and loading restrictions in the bay at Castelnau will be as stated in that schedule. The sole effect of this Order is to replicate and continue in force indefinitely the provisions of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Free Parking Places) (Limited Time) (No. 1) Experimental Order 2012.
- 4. The general effect of the **Waiting and Loading Restriction Order** is to make permanent the waiting restrictions in Castelnau and High Street, Teddington as stated in Schedule 2. The sole effect of this Order is to replicate and continue in force indefinitely the provisions of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Civil Enforcement Area) (No. 1) Experimental Order 2012.
- 5. Copies of the Orders which will come into operation on 12 September 2013, plans showing the location and effect of the proposals and the Council's Statement for making the Orders:-
 - (a) can be inspected can be inspected for a period of 6 weeks from the date of this notice, quoting Reference 13/097, at the Civic Centre (Central Reception, ground floor), 44 York Street, Twickenham between 9.15am and 5pm on Mondays to Fridays, except for Bank and other public holidays; and
 - (b) may be viewed on the Council's web-site at http://www.richmond.gov.uk/traffic_management_orders.htm
- 6. Copies of the Orders may be purchased from the Environment Directorate, Civic Centre, 44 York Street, Twickenham TW1 3BZ.
- 7. If any person wishes to question the validity of the Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of the said Act of 1984 or of any instrument made under

the said Act of 1984 has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders were made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 12 September 2013 and may be cited as the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Free Parking Places) (Limited Time) (Amendment No. 13) Order 2013.
- 2. (1) In this Order the expression "enactment" means any enactment whether public, general or local and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment.
 - (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
 - (3) The Interpretation Act 1978**(b)** shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Free Parking Places) (Limited Time) (Consolidation No. 1) Order 2008(c), as amended, shall apply as if:-
 - (a) there were added to the items in Schedule 17 to that order the item numbered 17/6 and as set out in columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of Schedule 1 to this order; and
 - (b) there were added to that order a new Schedule 20 with the item numbered 20/1 and as set out in columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of Schedule 2 to this order;
 - (c) there were added to that order a new Schedule 21 with item numbered 21/1 and as set out in columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of Schedule 3 to this order;
 - (d) there were added to that order a new Schedule 22 with item numbered 22/1 and as set out in columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of Schedule 4 to this order;

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order continues in force indefinitely the provisions of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Free Parking Places) (Limited Time) (No. 1) Experimental Order 2012. That Order introduced free, limited time, parking places where the maximum stay is 30 minutes in various streets throughout the borough. At each location the parking place has been created by removing a length of single yellow line, other than at Castelnau where the single yellow line will remain in force at times other than when the limited time parking bay is in operation.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

In March 2012 the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames introduced a number of free limited time parking bays where the maximum stay is 30 minutes at various locations throughout the borough. The opportunity has been taken to identify additional places where single yellow lines may be removed without affecting road safety or capacity.

The free parking places will encourage short stay parking in local shopping areas and are intended to boost trading within the borough.

This scheme was introduced on an experimental basis to give the Council powers to make modifications or variations to the scheme in the light of operational experience.

The Council has considered the outcome of the experiment and has decided to make the permanent Orders whose titles are given above and which reproduce and continue in force indefinitely the provisions of the experimental Orders.

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EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order continues in force indefinitely the provisions of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Waiting and Loading) (Civil Enforcement Area) (No. 1) Experimental Order 2012. That Order introduced short sections of waiting restrictions in locations where such measures have been identified within the scheme to review on-street parking and the introduction of 30 minute free parking bays.

In March 2012 the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames introduced a number of free limited time parking bays where the maximum stay is 30 minutes at various locations throughout the borough. The opportunity has been taken to identify additional places where single yellow lines may be removed without affecting road safety or capacity.

The free parking places will encourage short stay parking in local shopping areas and are intended to boost trading within the borough.

This scheme was introduced on an experimental basis to give the Council powers to make modifications or variations to the scheme in the light of operational experience.

The Council has considered the outcome of the experiment and has decided to make the permanent Orders whose titles are given above and which reproduce and continue in force indefinitely the provisions of the experimental Orders.
