Contravention in loading places

7. If a goods vehicle is left in a loading place designated by Schedule 1, Schedule 3, Schedule 5, Schedule 6, Schedule 7, Schedule 9, Schedule 10, Schedule 11, Schedule 19 or Schedule 20 for a continuous period of more than twenty minutes or in a loading place designated by Schedule 2, Schedule 4, Schedule 8, Schedule 12, Schedule 13, Schedule 15, Schedule 16, Schedule 18, Schedule 21, Schedule 23, Schedule 24, Schedule 25, Schedule 26, Schedule 27, Schedule 28 or Schedule 29 for a continuous period of more than one hour or in a loading place designated by Schedule 14 for a continuous period of more than two hours a contravention shall have occurred and a penalty charge shall be payable. If a vehicle other than a goods vehicle is left in a loading place designated in any of the Schedules previously referred to in this Article

during the permitted hours, a contravention shall have occurred and a penalty charge shall be payable.

The Council receives reports from time to time on matters of road safety caused by parked vehicles and these may come from residents, Councillors, Council officers or bus and emergency services. These matters include poor sight lines at junctions, obstruction of footway crossing points, lack of suitable passing areas and reduced carriageway width restricting or preventing access for vehicles especially emergency service vehicles.

The Orders make certain amendments to lengths of waiting restrictions, introduce two loading bays and make certain changes to a number of lengths of parking places.
