

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2) (b)

**Temporary Road Closure
Manor Gardens, Richmond**

(Ref: 16/037)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to the need to facilitate emergency gas main repair works and the likelihood of danger to the public, they will introduce a road closure in Manor Gardens, Richmond.
2. Whilst the works take place
 - (a) no person may permit a vehicle to enter or exit Manor Gardens at its junction with Manor Road; local access will be maintained where practicable for residents of Manor Gardens;
 - (b) the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Manor Gardens, Richmond) (One-Way Traffic) Order 1990 (1990/17) shall be suspended.

NOTE – There will be no access for vehicular traffic from Grena Road to Manor Road.

3. An alternative route for vehicles affected by the closure shall be available via Sheen Road, Clifford Avenue, Lower Richmond Road and Manor Road.
4. The restrictions will come into force on 17 February 2016. Further details regarding the dates and times of the closure are explained in paragraph 6 of this notice.
5. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer;
 - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
6. The temporary restrictions will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) (b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect on 17 February 2016 and remain in force at all times for a period of 21 days or until the works are completed, whichever is the sooner. The works are expected to be completed on 28 February 2016.
7. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
8. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
