DISABLED PERSONS PARKING BAYS VARIOUS STREETS THROUGHOUT THE BOROUGH

(Reference 16/185)

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames propose to make the above Order under sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- The principal objective of the Order is to introduce a number of parking places for disabled persons where a high level of parking makes reasonable means of access difficult, and to discontinue a number of parking places previously provided where the demand for such bays no longer exists.
- 3. The Order will introduce a parking bay for disabled persons' vehicles, operating "at any time" in the following streets:

Brinsworth Close, Twickenham; Rothesay Avenue, Richmond (2 bays);

Fairfax Road, Teddington; St Anns Road, Barnes; Kings Farm Avenue, Richmond; Watney Road, Mortlake

Palewell Park, East Sheen; Woodlawn Crescent. Twickenham.

4. The Order will revoke the existing parking bay for disabled persons' vehicles in the vicinity of the following properties:-

2 Albany Close, East Sheen;
43 Kings Road, East Sheen;
25 Limes Avenue Barnes;
17 Arlington Road, Teddington;
67 Lincoln Avenue, Twickenham;
40 Manor Grove, Richmond.

 - (3) The Interpretation Act 1978**(b)** shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Free Parking Places) (People with Disabilities) Order 2007(c), as amended, shall have effect as though
 - (a) there were added to the items in Schedule 2 to that Order the items numbered 22D, 70A, 122B, 182A, 203D, 204B, 258C and 270A; as set out in columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of Schedule 1 to this Order;
 - (b) the items numbered 1C, 9A, 122A, 138B, 141 and 152A in Schedule 2 to that Order set out in columns 1, 2, 3, and 4 of Schedule 3 to this Order were revoked

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THIS ORDER

1 Under delegated powers additional parking bays are proposed to be introduced for the exclusive use of Blue Badge holders who meet the criteria approved by the Transport Sub-Committee on 22 July 1996 and for any other vehicle displaying a valid disabled person's badge issued by a Local Authority.

The bays are situated: -

- (i) outside Nos14 Brinsworth Close, Twickenham:
- (ii) outside Nos 33 Fairfax Road, Teddington:
- (iii) outside No. 44 Kings Farm Avenue, Richmond;
- (iv) outside No 127 Palewell Park, East Sheen;
- (v) outside 446 Upper Richmo0nd Road West, Richmond bay in Rothesay Avenue, Richmond:
- (vi) outside No 36 St Ann's Road, Barnes;
- (vii) outside Nos 22 Watney Road , Mortlake
- (viii) outside No 5 Woodlawn Crescent. Twickenham.

and will be in operation at all times.

- The Council is also proposing to revoke or discontinue the use of the following bays, where there is no longer any demand for their use:-
 - (i) outside No 2 Albany Close, East Sheen;
 - (ii) outside No 17 Arlington Road, Teddington;
 - (iii) outside No 43 Kings Road, East Sheen;
 - (iv) outside No 25 Limes Avenue Barnes;
 - (v) outside No 67 Lincoln Avenue, Twickenham;
 - (vi) outside No 40 Manor Grove, Richmond.
