

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

## Temporary Waiting Restrictions Hospital Bridge Road, Whitton

(Reference 17/017)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to the likelihood of danger to the public arising from obstructive parking, they intend to make a temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a temporary prohibition of traffic in Hospital Bridge Road, Whitton.
2. Whilst the Order remains in force, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or stand on the east side of the western arm of Hospital Bride Road, from a point 0020 opposite No 223a, northwards to its junction with Nelson Road.
3. The order will come into effect on 29 January 2017. The restrictions will be in force at all times and the order will remain in force for a period of 18 months.
4. Nothing in the Order applies to:
  - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with any public service or utility vehicle;
  - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
  - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
5. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
