

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

**Temporary Waiting Restriction
Mary's Terrace, Twickenham**

(Ref: 18/075)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to obstructive parking they will introduce a waiting restriction in Mary's Terrace, Twickenham.
2. Whilst the Order remains in force, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or stand in Mary's Terrace from a point outside the south-western boundary of No 16 Mary's Terrace south-westwards to a point outside the rear of the south-western extremity of the of the garages to the rear of the Travelodge Hotel.
3. The Order came force on 2 April 2018 and continues ion force the provisions of a Notice made under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Order will remain in force at all times from 2 April 2018 for a maximum period of 18 months.
4. Nothing in this Order will apply to:
 - (a) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (b) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
5. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
6. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.

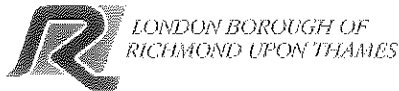

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to obstructive parking they will introduce a waiting restriction in Mary's Terrace, Twickenham.
2. Whilst the works take place, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or stand in Mary's Terrace from a point outside the south-western boundary of No 16 Mary's Terrace south-westwards to a point outside the rear of the south-western extremity of the of the garages to the rear of the Travelodge Hotel.
3. The restrictions will come into force on 28 March 2018. Further details regarding the dates and times of the restrictions are explained in paragraph 5 of this notice.
4. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
 - (a) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (b) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
5. The temporary restrictions will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect on 28 March 2018 and remain in force at all times for a period of 5 days. After this time the Council will introduce an Order made under S14(1) of the said Act to continue in force the provisions of this Notice for eighteen months.
6. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
7. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) (MARY'S TERRACE, TWICKENHAM) ORDER 2018

Made: 30 March 2018

Comes into operation: 2 April 2018

WHEREAS the Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (hereinafter referred to as "The Council") being the Highway Authority for all streets within the said London borough, with the exception of those streets which are part of the Transport for London Road Network and those which are Crown roads in the Royal Parks of Richmond Park and Bushy Park, are satisfied that vehicular traffic should be prohibited and car parking restricted in order to facilitate construction works to Twickenham Station (hereinafter referred to as "the works"):

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended, and of all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order: -

Commencement and citation

1. The order will come into effect on 2 April 2018 and maybe cited as the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (Mary's Terrace, Twickenham) Order 2018. The Order will be in force at all times from 2 April 2018 for a period of 18 months

Prohibition or restriction of vehicular traffic

2. Whilst the works take place, at all times from 2 April 2018 until 1 October 2019, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or stand in Mary's Terrace from a point outside the south-western boundary of No 16 Mary's Terrace south-westwards to a point outside the rear of the south-western extremity of the of the garages to the rear of the Travelodge Hotel.
3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply to any vehicle connected with the execution of the said works or to any public service or utility vehicle.
4. Nothing in this Order shall apply: -
 - (a) to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (b) to any vehicle on an occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes, if the observance of that provision would be likely to hinder the use of the vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used on that occasion, provided that conditions which prevail on site at any one time do not render it unsafe or impossible for such a vehicle or vehicles to use any part of the public highway for the time being.

5. The provisions of this Order will only apply during such times when it is necessary to prohibit or restrict vehicular traffic in that road or length of road and to such extent as is at the time indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016**(b)**.

Contravention

6. If a vehicle fails to comply with the provisions of this Order, a contravention shall be deemed to have occurred and a penalty charge shall be payable. A penalty charge notice showing the information required by the Traffic Management Act 2004**(c)** may then be issued by a civil enforcement officer in accordance with the requirements of that Act.

Manner of payment of the penalty charge

7. The penalty charge shall be paid to the Council as set out in Schedule 2 to the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Manner of Payment of Penalty Charges) Order 2011**(d)**.

Alteration of position or removal of vehicles

8. Where any vehicle is standing in contravention of the provisions of this Order, a civil enforcement officer may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle in order that its position shall comply with those provisions or he may, under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986**(e)**, as amended, remove or cause to be removed the vehicle and, where it is so removed, shall provide for the safe custody of the vehicle.
