ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 (2) (b)

Temporary Restrictions Kew Green, Kew

(Ref: 21/065)

- The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate the safe and expeditious movement of traffic and due to the likelihood of danger to the public following the installation of a new road layout, with the agreement of Transport for London, shall restrict vehicular traffic in Kew Green.
- 2. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to enter Kew Green, from the northern arm, from a point at the western kerb-line of Kew Road (A205).
- 3. Every vehicle proceeding in Kew Green in its south-western arm and the northern arm between the western kerb-line of the A205 and the south-western arm of Kew Green, shall cause that vehicle to proceed in a clockwise direction only, from south-east to north-west and from west to east.
- 4. The restrictions will come into force on 4 May 2021 and remain in force for a maximum period of 21 days. The Council is proposing to make an experimental traffic order to continue in force these restrictions. If after the aforementioned period of 21 days has elapsed, such an Order has not been made, the Council shall make an Order un Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to continue in force the provisions of this Notice for up to 18 months.
- 5. Signed alternative routes for vehicles affected by the closure will be available via adjacent streets
- 6. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
 - a) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer.
 - b) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
 - c) pedal cycles.
- 7. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 8. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
