ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 (2) (b)

Temporary Waiting Restricitons South Worple Way, East Sheen

(Ref: 21/101)

- The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to the need to remove obstructive parking and due to the likelihood of danger to the public, they will introduce wating restrictions in South Worple Way East Sheen.
- 2. Whilst the Notice remains in force, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or stand in the following lengths of road: -
 - (a) South Worple Way, southern side, from a point outside the common boundary of Nos 50 and 51 South Worple Way to a point outside the western boundary of No. 50 South Worple Way;
 - (b) South Worple Way, southern side, from a point outside the eastern boundary of No. 46 South Worple Way, westwards for a distance of 15 metres; and
 - (c) South Worple Way, southern side, from a point outside the common boundary of Nos 43 and 44 South Worple Way, eastwards for a distance of 26 metres.
- 3. The restrictions will come into force on 21 June 2021. Further details regarding the dates and times of the restrictions are explained in paragraph 5 of this notice.
- 4. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
 - (a) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer;
 - (b) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - (c) any vehicle being used in the carrying out of statutory duties or utility works.
- 5. The temporary restrictions will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) (b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect on 21 June 2021 and remain in force for a maximum period of 21 days. After this date, the Council will introduce an Order under S14(1) of the said Act of 1984 to continue in force the provisions of this Notice for up to 18 months.
- 6. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
