Temporary Closure PROW 228 Footpath Linking Cole Park Road and Mary's Terrace

(Reference 21/206)

- The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate groundwork and landscape works, they intend to make a temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a temporary closure in a length of PROW 228 – footpath linking Cole Park Road and Mary's Terrace.
- 2. Whilst the works take place, no person shall proceed in PROW 228 between Cole Park Road and Mary's Terrace.
- 3. An alternative route for pedestrians is available via Mary's Terrace, London Road and Cole Park Road and vice versa.
- 4. The order will come into effect on 6 December 2021. The restrictions will be in force from 6 December 2021 until 7 January 2022 and whilst signs/cones are in place. The order will remain in force for a period of 6 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
- 5. The prohibitions apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 6. Nothing in the Order applies to:
 - (a) any person requiring access in connection with the execution of the said works:
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (c) any person requiring access for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
