

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

**Temporary Closure**  
**PROW 228 Footpath Linking Cole Park Road and**  
**Mary's Terrace**

(Reference 21/206)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate groundwork and landscape works, they intend to make a temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a temporary closure in a length of PROW 228 – footpath linking Cole Park Road and Mary's Terrace.
2. Whilst the works take place, no person shall proceed in PROW 228 between Cole Park Road and Mary's Terrace.
3. An alternative route for pedestrians is available via Mary's Terrace, London Road and Cole Park Road and vice versa.
4. The order will come into effect on 6 December 2021. The restrictions will be in force from 6 December 2021 until 7 January 2022 and whilst signs/cones are in place. The order will remain in force for a period of 6 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
5. The prohibitions apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
6. Nothing in the Order applies to:
  - (a) any person requiring access in connection with the execution of the said works;
  - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
  - (c) any person requiring access for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
