



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

**Temporary Waiting Restriction
Bramble Lane, Hampton**

(Ref: 21/212)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate access to a SARS-CoV-2 testing centre, they have made a Temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which is to introduce a waiting restriction in Bramble Lane, Hampton.
2. Whilst the Order remains in force, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or stand in Bramble Lane in the areas indicated by signs.
3. The Order will come into effect on 2 December 2021. The restrictions will be in force at all times from 2 December 2021 until 31 March 2022.
4. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
5. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Notice may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
