That part of The Embankment hatched in black on the plan titled "Areas of Public Highway to be Stopped Up Location Plan," consisting of an area of 686.8m² running from a point east to west to the south of the Diamond Jubilee Gardens and wrapping round the western corner onto the southern end of Wharf Lane.
- 3. That part of the Service Road hatched in black on the plan titled "Areas of Public Highway to be Stopped Up Location Plan," consisting of an area of 20.5m² which is the southern side of the turning circle at the eastern end.
