ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 (1)

Temporary Parking Suspension Cowley Road, Mortlake

(Ref: 22/001)

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate a gas main replacement works they intend to make a temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a suspension for a Welfare Unit in Cowley Road, Mortlake.
- 2. Whilst the works take place no person may permit a vehicle to wait or stand adjacent to Nos. 268-272 Mortlake High Street (in Cowley Road), where indicated by traffic signs/cones on the east side, from a point 6 metres south of the southern kerb-line of Mortlake High Street southwards for a distance of 22.5 metres,
- 3. The order will come into effect on 10 January 2022. The works are anticipated to be in progress from 10 January 2022 until 23 February 2022. The order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
- 4. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 5. Nothing in the Order will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (c) emergency service vehicles, subject to site conditions at the time of any emergency.
- 6. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
