ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 (1)

Waiting Restriction Alder Road, Mortlake

(Ref: 22/012)

- The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate emergency vehicle access and due to the likelihood of danger to the public they have made a Temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which is to introduce a parking suspension in Alder Road, Mortlake.
- 2. Whilst the Notice remains in force, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or stand in the following lengths of Alder Road: -
 - (a) western side, from the south-western kerb-line of Vineyard Path, southwards for 50 metres;
 - (b) western side, from the northern kerb-line of North Worple Way, northwards for a distance of 26.5 metres;
 - (c) eastern side, from the northern kerb-line of North Worple Way, northwards for a distance of 30 metres;
 - (d) eastern side, from a point 35 metres north of the northern kerb-line of North Worple Way, northwards for a distance of 5 metres;
 - (e) eastern side, from a point 46.5 metres south of the south-western kerb-line of Vineyard Path, southwards for a distance of 22 metres.
- 3. The Order shall come into force on 21 January 2022. The Order will remain in force for 18 months.
 - Nothing in this Order will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer: or
 - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
 - 5. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Notice may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
