ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

Temporary Waiting Restrictions Edgar Road, Hanworth Road and Simpson Road, Whitton

(Ref: 22/043)

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate delivery of modular units they intend to make a temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a parking suspension in Edgar Road, Hanworth Road and Simpson Road, Whitton.
- 2. Whilst the works take place, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or stand in the following lengths of road: -
- (a) Hanworth Road, both sides, from a point 25 metres south-west of the south-western kerb-line of Simpson to a point 50 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line of Simpson Road
- (b) Simpson Road, from its junction with Hanworth Road to the end of the cul de sac,
- (c) Edgar Road, from its junction with Simpson Road, south-westwards for a distance of 10 metres.
- 3. The order will come into effect on 21 February 2022. The works are anticipated to be in progress for a period of 4 days i.e. until 24 February 2022. The order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
- 4. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 5. Nothing in the Order will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (c) emergency service vehicles, subject to site conditions at the time of any emergency.
- 6. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
