- 2. The general effect of the **Waiting and Loading Restriction Amendment Order** will be to introduce lengths of yellow lines as set out in the schedule to this Notice.
- 3. The general effects of the **Disabled Persons Parking Places Order** will be to introduce parking bays as detailed in the Schedule to this Notice.
- 4. Copies of the proposed Order, plans showing the location and effect of the proposals and the Council's Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Order: -

SCHEDULE

Street	Details
Bishops Close, Ham:	To extend the existing double yellow lines at the junction of Ham Common so that they extend to approximately 17.5 metres north of that junction.
Blandford Road and Hampton Road, Teddington:	To introduce lengths of double yellow lines ("no waiting at any time") at both junctions of Blandford Road with its junction with Hampton Road.
Chertsey Road, Twickenham	To introduce double yellow lines ("no waiting at any time") on the southeastern side of Chertsey Road between a point outside the south-western boundary of No. 404 Chertsey Road and the south-western kerb-line of Meadway.
Church Street, Hampton:	To introduce double yellow lines ("no waiting at any time") outside St Mary's Church, Church Street.
Fairways, Teddington:	To upgrade lengths of single yellow line to double yellow line (*no waiting at any time") and introduce lengths of double yellow lines in Fairways between its junction worth Broom Road and a point outside and opposite the eastern boundary of No. 11 Fairways.
Fife Road, East Sheen:	To introduce double yellow lines ("no waiting at any time") at the junction of Fife Road and The Mall.
Ham Common and Martingales Road. Ham:	To introduce a length of double yellow line ("no waiting at any time") in Ham Common, west of its junction with Martingales Close, on the western side of Martingales Close at its junction with Ham Common, and outside No. 53 Ham Common.
Kingston Road and Bushy Park Road, Teddington:	To introduce a disabled persons' parking bay in the vicinity of No. 5 The Pavement, Bushy Park Road and introduce double yellow lines ("no waiting at any time") and a loading restriction operating between 7am and 7pm on all days of the week on the south-western side of Kingston between a point outside No 212 Kingston Road and a point outside No. 222 Kingston Road.

Kingston Road, Teddington:	To extend the existing double yellow line ("no waiting at any time") from the north-western kerb-line of Marston Road by 7 metres in the north-westerly direction.
Orchard Road, Richmond:	To introduce a 6 metre length of double yellow lines ("no waiting at any time") in Orchard Road, outside the access to the bin storage area outside Nos 1-32 Orchard Road.
Palewell Common Drive, East Sheen:	To introduce double yellow lines ("no waiting at any time") in Palewell Common Drive around the fire gate, to facilitate access.
Runnymede Close, Twickenham:	To introduce double yellow lines ("no waiting at any time") in Runnymede on the western side, northern extremity and on its eastern side between the cul de sac and the northern end of the grass verge,
St Vincent Road, Twickenham:	To introduce double yellow lines ("no waiting ant any time") on the eastern side of St Vincent Road between Nos 2 and 12 and to remove 2 footway parking spaces outside No. 2 and Nos. 6 and 8.
Springfield Road, Twickenham:	To introduce double yellow lines ("no waiting at any time") in Springfield Road, outside Nos. 34 and 36 to around the fire hydrant.
Waverley Avenue, Twickenham	To Introduce 4 metre lengths of double yellow lines ("no waiting at any time") in outside No. 51 and 87 Waverley Avenue, Twickenham to facilitate access to fire hydrants.
Westhay Gardens and West Temple Sheen, East Sheen:	To introduce double yellow lines ("no waiting at any time") at the junction of Westhay Gardens and West Temple Sheen.
West Temple Sheen, East Sheen	To introduce double yellow lines ("no waiting at any time") in the turning circle of West Temple Sheen.
