

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

Temporary Bus Lane Suspension Eton Street and Paradise Road, Richmond

(Reference 22/127)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate water pipe repairs they intend to make a Temporary Traffic Order the effect of which is to introduce bus lane suspensions in Eton Street and Paradise Road.
2. Whilst the works take place, the bus lanes in Eton Street and Paradise Road, Richmond shall be suspended.
3. The order will come into effect on 6 June 2022 will be in force at all times from 6 June 2022 until 8 June 2022 where relevant signs are placed. The order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the sooner.
4. Nothing in the Order applies to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used, or any person in connection with the execution of the said works;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
