ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 (1)

Temporary Bus Lane Suspension Eton Street and Paradise Road, Richmond

(Reference 22/127)

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate water pipe repairs they intend to make a Temporary Traffic Order the effect of which is to introduce bus lane suspensions in Eton Street and Paradise Road.
 - 2. Whilst the works take place, the bus lanes in Eton Street and Paradise Road, Richmond shall be suspended.
 - 3. The order will come into effect on 6 June 2022 will be in force at all times from 6 June 2022 until 8 June 202 where relevant signs are placed. The order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the sooner.
 - 4. Nothing in the Order applies to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used, or any person in connection with the execution of the said works;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
