ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

Temporary Restrictions Evelyn Road, Richmond

(Reference 22/149)

- The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate development works, they intend to make a temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a temporary restriction of traffic in Evelyn Road, Richmond.
- 2. Whilst the works take place, two-way working will be permitted in Evelyn Road between its junction with Kew Foot Road and the entrance to the Richmond Royal Hospital site.
- 3. The order will come into effect on 4 July 2022. The restrictions will be in force at all times from 4 July 2022 until 3 January 2023 and whilst signs/cones are in place. The order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
- 4. The prohibitions apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 5. Nothing in the Order applies to:
 - (a) any public service or utility vehicle:
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
- 6. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
