ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

Temporary Waiting Restricitons Hawkins Road and Kingston Lane, Teddington

(Ref: 22/163)

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate a water connection they intend to make a temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to introduce temporary waiting restrictions in Hawkins Road and Kingston Lane, Teddington.
- 2. Whilst the works take place no person may permit a vehicle to wait or stand in the following lengths of road:-
 - (a) Hawkins Road, the east side, from its junction with Kingston Lane, southwards for a distance of 25 metres;
 - (b) Kingston Lame, the north side, from a point opposite the eastern kerb-line of Hawkins Road, westwards for a distance of 50 metres;
 - (c) Kingston Lane, the south side, from the western kerb-line of Hawkins Road, westwards for a distance of 25 metres.
- 3. The order will come into effect on 25 July 2022. The works are anticipated to be in progress from 25 July 2022 until 28 July 2022. The order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
- 4. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 5. Nothing in the Order will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (c) emergency service vehicles, subject to site conditions at the time of any emergency.
- 6. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
