- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames propose to make the above Order under sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The principal objective of the **Disabled Persons' Parking Places Order** is to introduce a number of parking places for disabled persons where a high level of parking makes reasonable means of access difficult, and to discontinue a number of parking places previously provided where the demand for such bays no longer exists.
- 3. The **Disabled Persons' Parking Places Order** will introduce a parking bay for disabled persons' vehicles, operating "at any time" in the following streets:
