

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 16A

**THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF
TRAFFIC) (SPECIAL EVENTS) (OUT OF THE BLUE EVENT) ORDER 2023****YORK STREET, TWICKENHAM**

(Reference 23/111)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames hereby gives notice that on 23 June 2023 they made the above-named Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The general effect of the Order is to facilitate the holding of the “Out of the Blue” event in Twickenham.
3. From 8am until 7pm on Saturday 1st July 2023, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed, wait or stand in York Street, Twickenham between its junctions with Arragon Road and London Road.
4. A signed diversion route for traffic affected by the closures will be available in adjacent streets.
5. Nothing in this Order will apply to:
 - (a) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a Police Constable, Police Community Support Officer or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
 - (b) any vehicle being used by a statutory undertaker, whereby it is necessary by reason of an emergency, for that vehicle to have access to part of the street under restriction.
6. The prohibitions or restrictions specified in this notice will apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
- 6.. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
