

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

**Temporary Road Closure
Teddington Suspension Footbridge and Lock Cut
Footbridge, Teddington**

(Reference 23/121)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate structural refurbishment works, they intend to make a temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to introduce temporary closures of both Teddington Suspension Footbridge and Lock Cut Footbridge, Teddington.
2. Whilst the works take Place both footbridges will be closed to foot pedestrians.
3. The order will come into effect on 25 July 2023. The works are anticipated to be in progress at all times between 25 July and 31 December 2023. The order will remain in force for a period of 6 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
4. An alternative route for pedestrians affected by the closure will be available via Kingston Bridge or Richmond Bridge (A305).
5. The prohibitions apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
6. Nothing in the Order applies to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (c) emergency service vehicles, subject to site conditions at the time of any emergency.
7. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
