DISABLED PERSONS PARKING BAYS VARIOUS STREETS THROUGHOUT THE BOROUGH

(Reference 23/123)

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames propose to make the above Order under sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- The principal objective of the **Disabled Persons' Parking Places Order** is to introduce a number of parking places for disabled persons where a high level of parking makes reasonable means of access difficult, and to discontinue a number of parking places previously provided where the demand for such bays no longer exists.
- 3. The **Disabled Persons' Parking Places Order** will introduce a parking bay for disabled persons' vehicles, operating "at any time" in the following streets:

Bloxham Crescent, Hampton Cowley Road, Mortlake Devon Avenue, Twickenham Gilpin Avenue, East Sheen Malvern Road, Hampton Palewell Park, East Sheen Percival Road, East Sheen Rosecroft Gardens, Twickenham Twickenham Road, Teedington Windmill Road, Hampton Clevedon Road, Twickenham
Darell Road, Richmond
Enmore Gardens, East Sheen
Hospital Bridge Road, Twickenham
Nowell Road, Barnes
Palewell Park, East Sheen
Princes Road, Teddington
Rosemont Road, Richmond
Upper Richmond Road West, East Sheen

4. The **Disabled Persons' Parking Places Order** will also revoke the existing parking bays for disabled persons' vehicles in the vicinity of the following properties: -

12 Alexandra Road, Twickenham 7 Grena Road, Richmond 10 Plevna Road, Hampton 46 Fifth Cross Road, Twickenham 81 Lambert Avenue, Richmond 158 Nelson Road, Twickenham

1 Melville Road, Barnes9 Rectory Road, Barnes35 Meadway, Twickenham58 Staines Road, Twickenham82 Victor Road, Teddington
