PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) (SPECIAL EVENTS) (REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY) ORDER
2023****REMEMBRANCE DAY COMMEMORATIONS**

(Reference 23/193)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames hereby gives notice that on 6 November 2023 they made the above-named Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The purpose of the Order is to facilitate the holding of Remembrance Sunday commemorations. The Order will be in force on Sunday 12 November 2023 only.
3. The effects of the Order are that whilst the events are taking place, the restrictions detailed in the Schedule to this Notice shall be in force in the roads specified at the times stated.
4. Nothing in this Order will apply to:
 - (a) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a Police Constable or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
 - (b) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
5. The prohibitions or restrictions specified in this notice will apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
6. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
