ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 (1)

Temporary Waiting Restrictions Bicester Road and Lambert Avenue, Richmond Meadlands Drive, Ham

(Reference 24/073)

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate delivery and collection of temporary accommodation to facilitate the holding of the Mayoral and Greater London Authority Elections, they intend to make a temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a temporary prohibition of traffic in the above-mentioned roads.
- 2. Whilst the works take place, no person may permit a vehicle to wait or stand in the lengths of streets at the times specified on the Schedule to this Notice.
- 3. The order will come into effect on 30 April 2024. The works are anticipated to be in progress from 30 April 2024 until 4 May 2024. The provisions of the order will be in force where relevant signs/cones are placed. The order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
- 4. The prohibitions apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 5. Nothing in the Order applies to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (c) any vehicle being used for Police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes..
- 6. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
